The ObsiLab is addressed to Master's and doctorate students with previous experience in lithic studies, who wish to deepen the main aspects (archaeometry, technology, traceology) of prehistoric obsidian production.

Located at the westermost and widest Mediterranean obsidian source, 100 hours of both lectures and lab activities will provide a updated and comprehensive approach to the domain of obsidian technology.

Fieldwork (geological and archaeological survey, excavation and documentation of an obsidian workshop, experimental use of obsidian tools) encompasses some of the principal topics of the obsidian production analysis.

The intact and wild Monte Arci landscape, less than 20 kilometers from the sea, gives the opportunity to experience the beauties and the thousand years old culture of the Sardinian land.
